Interpretation Practice:

Find a passage of scripture you would like to study and then ask the following questions:

- 1. What is the author's intended meaning in the passage?
- 2. What is the author's intended message?
- 3. What is the universal truth I can draw out?
- 4. How can I apply it to my world and my life?

Interpretation Steps:

Find another passage of Scripture and follow the steps:

- 1. Observe and find out what the text says by answering the following questions:
 - Who wrote the text and who is it written to?
 - What is the context? What is the main idea?
 - When was it written?
 - Where was the author? Where was the audience?
 - How do we apply, understand and interact with the text?
- 2. Interpret by asking these questions:
 - -What did the text mean to its original readers?
 - -Why does the text say what it does?
- 3. Apply by asking these questions:

What does the text mean for us today?

What are the universal timeless principles relevant today?
